OPINION OF THE COURT

McKee, Circuit Judge.

Bensalem Township Officers Fred Schumann and Andy Anisman, and Detective Bob Juno appeal the order of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania denying their combined motion for relief from a default judgment.
